STAY SAFE!

Winter is here, the evenings are getting darker, so it's important that we know all the various ways we can keep our children safe. Children often cover this as a topic in schools and there are plenty of useful websites but we need to be aware of the dangers and what we can do to keep them safe outside of school and club.

Walking home from school or even just crossing the road in the dark can be dangerous. Children wearing dark trousers, coats and carrying dark coloured bags are not very visible to motorists, even in the day time. Wearing bright or fluorescent clothes are best in the day even in dull or misty weather. In the dark however fluorescent clothing doesn't work so using reflective tape on a coat or school bag helps you to be seen by drivers. You can buy reflective gear from cycle stores or zip clips, badges and stickers online. Some clothes shops even have a range of reflective Τhe website clothing. http://talesoftheroad.direct.gov.uk/be-bright.php has lots of information for children as well as parents to have look at and investigate.

Teaching children to be vigilant and aware of stranger danger is another vital way for them to stay safe. At Kids Collective children do not leave without an adult. However, other children do walk home by themselves. Teaching children to stay safe and be smart without frightening them will help them be confident to keep themselves safe. Talk to them calmly and help them to recognise the techniques that strangers could use to attract their attention. For example not getting to close to cars that stop for directions, not going with anyone they don't know to see a puppy or have some sweets and encourage children who are walking home to walk in groups.
